

Options when Combined Test Cannot be Offered

Maternity Services

It has not been possible to measure the nuchal translucency of your baby today:

Your pregnancy is more than 14 weeks and 1 day.

You will now be offered the Quadruple Test to screen for Down's syndrome only.

It may be possible to have the blood test taken at scan today or can be done at your routine 16 week appointment with your midwife. It is important that you are weighed in kilograms on the day of the blood test and that this weight is entered on the form.

It was not possible to obtain the necessary views of the baby.

You have the following options:

- Have the Quadruple Test as above on or after

- Have a private scan which may be able to obtain the views required. A repeat scan may be able obtain the views required.
