SHARED CARE TEAMS FOR CHILDREN WITH INHERITED BLEEDING DISORDERS

Oxford Paediatric Haemostasis Unit (PHU) has links with surrounding DGHs in the form of a lead Consultant Paediatrician (see below) as a point of contact. The role of the lead is to ensure that notes and out of hours Open Door Access are in place should the child require emergency admission to their local for whatever reason. The local hospital will then be aware of the diagnosis, have copies of all the letters from the CCC in Oxford and know who to contact for management advice. The local lead consultant is not required to see the child for regular clinic review, as they are seen in Oxford regularly. If the child has other paediatric issues being managed at their local then the local lead will liaise with Oxford and ensure that Oxford has copies of all local letters between other local health care professionals.
